

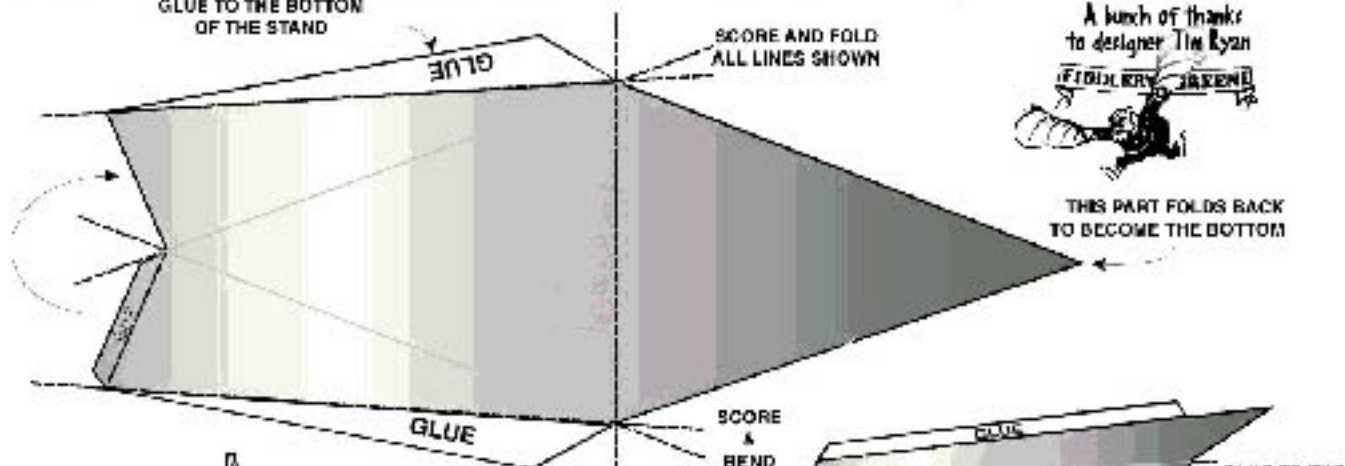
# Airplane Display Stands

GLUE TO THE BOTTOM OF THE STAND

SCORE AND FOLD ALL LINES SHOWN



THIS PART FOLDS BACK TO BECOME THE BOTTOM

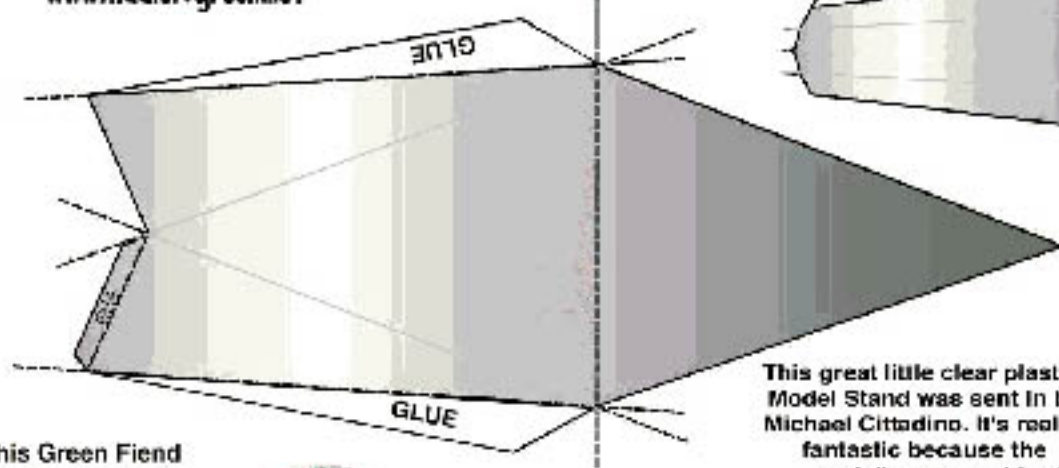


THIS IS WHAT IT'LL LOOK LIKE

GLUE TO THE BACK OF THE BASE

MODEL GOES HERE

BEND PLASTIC ALONG HERE

CUT ALONG OUTSIDE LINE

Showing the two types of stands



Trace this pattern onto stiff plastic sheet and cut around the OUTSIDE lines. Score the MIDDLE line and gently bend to shape. Cut little triangular hole in bottom of the model's fuselage just aft of the wings to take the tip of the stand. A little glue at the joining would be nice
